



KENNETT AREA PARK AND RECREATION 2010 SUMMER CAMP POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Welcome to the 2010 KAPRB Summer Camp Program. Our goal is to provide exceptional care, fun filled days and educational experiences for all of our campers. This program is provided for your fun and enjoyment. Your cooperation, good sportsmanship and communication are important in making this a successful camp season.

1. PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS

The appropriate age range for children participating in our program is ages 5 – 13. Campers are required to live in the Kennett Area. Consideration will be given to children who live outside the Kennett Area.

2. TRANSPORTATION

Transportation to and from camp on a daily basis is the responsibility of the camper. KAPRB will provide transportation to and from Mary D. Lang Elementary School for field trips.

3. PAYMENT

- The cost of camp for one child is \$520.00. The cost of camp for a second child of the same family is \$490.00. The cost of camp for a third child of the same family is \$450.00.
- Completed registration form and full payment is due to confirm your registration.
- Payments made are non-refundable after the start of camp.
- We will provide a very limited number of weekly camp registrations. The weekly cost is \$100.00.

4. CANCELLATION/REFUNDS

- There is a \$25.00 processing fee for all cancellations.
- If you would like to cancel one or more weeks before the start of camp, you must file a request in writing to KAPRB. Cancellations will not be accepted via telephone or fax.
- A full refund will be given for cancellations made up to the camp start date of Monday June 1, 2010.



- Absolutely no refunds or partial refund will be given if you withdraw your child, your child has missed days for any reason or is expelled for misbehavior.
- If a refund is granted, the refund will be prorated by the number of weeks attended times the weekly rate of \$100.00 subtracted from the original registration amount paid.
- A \$25.00 service charge will be attached to any check returned by the bank for insufficient funds.

5. DISCRIMINATION AND WELFARE POLICY

KAPRB does not discriminate based on race, creed, color, ethnicity, national origin or sex. KAPRB is mandated to report all suspected and visual signs of child abuse or neglect to the Department of Social and Health Services of Child Protective Services for the State of PA.

6. INCLUSION

KAPRB welcomes students of all levels of ability. If your child has a special need(s), you are required to contact our Recreation Coordinator, Claire Finfrock two (2) weeks prior to the start of camp to explain any special requirements so your child can have a positive experience.

7. SNACKS, LUNCH & DRINKS

KAPRB does not provide snacks or lunch. It is suggested that campers bring their own. We want the camp experience to be as focused as possible, so we ask that sugar snacks be kept to a minimum.

8. MEDICATIONS

Please make sure that medications have been given prior to arrival at camp. Please inform the staff in writing about any medication issues, including medications that will need to be taken during camp hours. (Please note: The KAPRB staff will not be responsible for administering medications.)

9. BEHAVIOR

Fun and safety are only possible when there are behavior guidelines. Campers are expected to show respect for fellow campers, counselors, staff and camp property. Disruptive behavior and physical aggression are not acceptable.

KAPRB Summer Camp staff will make every effort to provide a positive experience for campers. If a camper cannot live within the rules of the camp or the camper's behavior adversely affects the experiences of other children, KAPRB reserves the right to issue a warning



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to the camper and parent/guardian. KAPRB Summer Camp will not accept behaviors such as profanity, disrespect and inappropriate actions or any unsafe behaviors that are potentially harmful to themselves or to others.

If a situation arises where a camper threatens the safety or security of another camper, or if a camper shows disregard for camp guidelines, we will make every appropriate effort to inform the parents involved, and to correct the behavior and provide a positive camp experience for everyone. However, should disruptive behavior continue, the child may be dismissed from the camp at the discretion of KAPRB.

10. **BEFORE AND AFTERCARE PROGRAM**

KAPRB will provide before and aftercare for campers only. Please check with the camp director for specifics related to scheduled hours for pre and post camp care and rates.
